

General requirements for short-term Greek (Schengen) visa

- **Application form:** A complete and signed visa application form.
- **Passport:** A valid passport with at least two blank pages, valid for a minimum of three months beyond your stay.
- **Proof of funds:** Bank statements or other documents to prove you have sufficient funds for your stay. A general guideline is to show a minimum of €60-€70 per day of stay.
- **Travel insurance:** A travel medical insurance policy with a minimum coverage of €30,000 valid in all Schengen countries.
- **Itinerary:** A detailed travel plan, including flight reservations and hotel bookings for the duration of your stay.
- **Cover letter:** A letter explaining the purpose of your visit to Greece.
- **Proof of civil status:** Documents like a birth certificate, marriage certificate, or death certificate if applicable.

Important considerations

- **Health Declaration:** All travelers must complete a Health Declaration E-Form before entering the country.
- **Length of stay:** If you are staying for longer than 90 days, you will need a long-term national visa, not a Schengen visa.
- **Official sources:** Requirements can vary based on your country of origin and the specific purpose of your travel. Always consult the official website of the Greek embassy or consulate in your country for the most accurate and up-to-date information.
